Social Networks: Subcommunication or a Tool for the Formation of Mass Consciousness? Towards a Classification of Social Networks

Abstract

The article considers a completely new classification of social networks. The author identifies two types of social networks. The first type includes social networks forming subcommunication and leading users to the virtual world. The second type is associated with the platforms that actively affect the audience and form in people's minds the picture of the world necessary to achieve certain goals. Such social networks act as a collective organizer and contribute to the formation of mass consciousness and behavior, despite the personalistic nature of communication on these networks. Thus, this type of social media often affects the real life of users. The most typical functions of each particular social network represent a very important aspect in the context of identifying these types. The research was conducted on the material of three social networks: Ask.ru, Ask.fm and VKontakte. Ask.ru and Ask.fm are considered to be platforms that form subcommunication. VKontakte exemplifies social networks affecting the users' life.

Media Education of Schoolchildren in Russia: from Proto Formats to a Consensual Approach

Abstract

This article presents a historical analysis of domestic academic approaches to film education and information literacy as predecessors of modern media education. Because of the historical dispute

among pedagogues, librarians and media researchers, there is no conventional definition of media education and media literacy in Russia. In the article, the author makes an attempt to combine the existing definitions of film education, information literacy and media literacy to compose a new definition of media education. Each part of the article describes one of the media educational concepts in the context of pedagogical practices at different periods of history: genesis, practical utilitarian period, aesthetic period and social-cultural concepts. In conclusion, the author sums up the analysis combining the historical practices. And at the very end, the possibility of cooperation of film education, information literacy and media education is discussed.

International News Coverage of Foreign Countries: Cases of Russian and US Quality Newspapers

Abstract

This article considers the characteristics of representation of foreign states in Russian and US foreign reporting in 1995 and 2015. Based on the content analysis of American (The Los Angeles Times and The Philadelphia Inquirer) and Russian newspapers (Rossiyskaya Gazeta, Izvestia, Novaya Gazeta and Kommersant) the author attempts to find out the preferences of the media when it comes to the choice of the covered countries. The results of this research demonstrate different approaches to the coverage of foreign states by the press of the two countries that represent different media systems. Overall, the countries most actively covered by the US press were mainly countries that were involved in conflicts, as well as countries that were going through major crises. The press in Russia mostly focused on events in a geographically, culturally and historically close country – Ukraine, which also struggled from an internal armed conflict in 2015. The author also notes that 'elite' states generally dominate the agenda of Russian newspapers in 1995 and 2015, however this trend is not observed in American foreign reporting. In the press of both countries, there is a noticeable increase in the tendency to select foreign news corresponding to Russia's / US geopolitical interests.

In response to the long-lasting financial crisis, the traditional ways of fund raising are becoming less available and less attractive, and the "crowd" can be a good alternative. The analysis of crowdfunding projects in photojournalism on the Kickstarter platform, which was conducted by the author of this study, showed the still positive dynamics of financing growth and the comparableness of the obtained data with the general tendencies of the site under consideration. In spite of the fact that the most part of the analyzed projects were launched by American authors, the geography of crowdfunding is really wide and covers practically all the regions. Notably, this applies to both authors and donors. The study defines the threshold values of the raised money and their importance for predicting the campaign success. Only 6% of the campaigns which reached the milestone of 20% of the required sum become failures.

This study indicates that crowdfunding as a model of financing photographic projects proves its worth and can equip photojournalists with an effective tool for raising money.

Towards the Radioification of the Republic of Buryatia in the 1920s

Abstract

The article presents the results of a historiographic study into the initial stage of the formation of domestic broadcasting on the example of Buryat radio. The 1920s in science have not yet been sufficiently studied in terms of the stated topic, which is accounted for by a limited empirical base. Yet the documents preserved in the republican archives, as well as materials of press publications of that time, made it possible to restore in chronological order the important process of radiofication in this region, to reveal herein the special role of the radio amateur movement and the activities of the Society of Friends of Radio. A quantitative analysis of the thematic materials of the socio-political newspaper "Buryat-Mongolskaya Pravda" (1926–1929) showed that the peak of publication activity on the subject of radio communication occurred in 1927, when radio installation was put into operation in Verkhneudinsk. The events were mainly reported in news items, whose authors were for the most part members of the Society of Friends of Radio. In 1929, this organization significantly reduced its participation in the promotion of radio engineering and broadcasting in the local press. The experimental period of Buryatia's radio ended, the history of which was inextricably linked with the work of radio amateurs.

In the year of the 125th anniversary of the invention of radio, the topic of the research seems to be especially relevant.

Media Transit of the Theme of Social Orphanhood: Research Potential

Abstract

The ways of making media coverage of social problems more effective have become a real issue nowadays.

This article presents an innovative approach to the research of representations of social issues in mass media, within which it is supposed to create a research algorithm using the example of coverage of social orphanhood in Russian mass media based on such materials as newspaper articles, reviews, news items and the like. The problem of social orphanhood as one of the priority social problems in Russia has been considered to date. Mass media are presented as a tool for shaping public consciousness in relation to the problem. The article analyzes the role of mass media in the formation of media careers and media transit of the theme of social orphanhood. The article contains a brief overview of the pilot study publications and official statistical data. It also presents the prospects for the study of the problem. The author of the article believes that although there is a tendency for a decrease of social orphans in our country, the general scale of the issue calls for immediate actions. Abstract

The topic of preserving national identity occupies a significant place on the agenda of Swiss mass media and attracts the active attention of Internet users. The article presents the results of a study of audience requests on this topic in the Swiss segment of the Internet. The processing of the statistical data and the interpretation of the results of mediometric analysis was carried out on the basis of a media geographical approach focusing on the transformation of meanings in space and time in the process of constructing media reality. The empirical base of the study was made up of statistical data from Google Trends search engine and publications from Swiss mass media.
